


In COVID Times

- Facts:
 - We don't know when we will be allowed to 'return to normal' or what the new normal looks like
 - We don't know when we will be allowed to travel
 - We don't yet know what post-secondary for fall 2020 will look like
 - Many students feel like they are missing out on their grade 12 experience
 - Many students (and parents) have lost jobs and might not be able to afford university/college

In COVID Times

- Predictions:
 - Many grade 12's will return for 1 semester to get closure
 - Families will need extra time to pay for school
 - Families will be more nervous about kids moving away from home
 - Online/distance learning will take a stronger place in higher ed programs
 - Students will opt to study part-time in postsecondary


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
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In COVID Times


What do the statistics say?

American Youth took gap years because....

- 92% wanted to gain experiences, personal growth
- 81% wanted a break from academic track
- 52% wanted to explore academic pursuits
- 44% wanted to explore careers
- 7% were not admitted to college
- British Youth took gap years because....
- 40% wanted to build independence
- 24% wanted a break from studies
- 17% needed to earn money
- 10% wanted to gain work experience
- 9% responded other

What are post-secondaries saying?

Post-secondary

- Two options: (1) Apply during your gap year (2) Apply in grade 12 and defer your acceptance.
- Applying Out of Phase:
 - Gappers are not penalized, they are coded differently in the back-end system
 - Grade 12 grades (or upgraded marks) count in the same way
 - Supplemental applications can be more robust with gap year experiences included
- Deferrals
 - After receiving an acceptance, look into the school and program's policies
 - We recommend this pathway IF you know what you want to study on the it provides reassurance for student/parents in the gap year decision.



Should You Take Time Off?

Each year, between 80 and 110 students defer their matriculation to Harvard College, and they report their experiences to be uniformly positive. In fact, students have created the <u>Harvard Gap Year Society</u>, which is designed to support students who are taking or have taken a gap year, as well as promote the benefits of taking a year off.

We encourage admitted students to defer enrollment for one year to travel, pursue a special project or activity, work, or spend time in another meaningful way—provided they do not enroll in a degree-granting program at another college. Deferrals for twoyear military service are also granted.






Deferral of Admission for Undergraduate Students

York University recognizes that after accepting an offer of admission some applicants have legitimate reasons for requesting a deferral of their admission to allow them to start their studies at a later semester start date. Although some programs do not allow this, in most cases requesting a deferred entry is possible and quite straight-forward. The deferral request process ensures that all admission conditions are satisfied before a deferral is granted. Deferral requests may be granted for up to a maximum of one calendar year.

If you plan to complete any further studies at an accredited institution after accepting your offer of admission to York, you will have to reapply for admission to a future session and provide transcripts from the institution that you attend in order to be reconsidered for admission. This form is for requesting deferral only and cannot be used for making a reapplication.



- Allow a minimum of two weeks for processing of a Request for Deferral.
- Once your deferral is processed, the University will send you an official decision notification. If you are an international student, a new offer and immigration letter will be produced.
- Need to change the start term for your deferral?
 - Accept your previous Deferral of Admission.

A.4.5 Deferral of Admission 🖨

Offers of admission are only valid for the term outlined in the admission letter. Students who are not registered in a course(s) after the course drop deadline for this term must re-apply for admission, unless they are approved for a deferral of admission.

Requests for deferral of admission are available to students who are applying directly from high school and have not attended another post-secondary institution. Requests may be submitted after a student has been admitted and paid the \$500.00 admission deposit. Deferral requests may be submitted in writing to the Associate Registrar, Recruitment and Admissions who will consult with the Faculty to which the student has been admitted. Deferrals are only approved for special circumstances and will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Students who attend another post-secondary institution during the deferral period will have the deferral cancelled and must re-apply for admission.

Students admitted to the Cumming School of Medicine (MD program), Veterinary Medicine, and Law see the faculty website for admission deferral information.



Applications and offers of admission are only valid for the program, year and session

indicated. We can't defer admissions.







Request to Defer Admissions

Deferral of Admissions for Undergraduate students

St Francis Xavier (StFX) University recognizes that after being admitted some applicants experience unique personal circumstances that may warrant a deferral of admission to the next academic year. StFX will grant a deferral at its discretion for exceptional cases. Approval of deferral requests may be granted one time only for up to one year. A final grade 12 transcript is required by **August 15th** and all entrance conditions must be satisfied before a new acceptance letter will be issued. If you plan to complete any studies at an accredited institution after being admitted to StFX, you must reapply for admission as a transfer student.

A student may qualify to defer their acceptance when all of the following exist:

- Have been accepted to StFX and have paid their \$100 confirmation fee
- Have submitted proper documentation with the application (Visa refusal letter, medical note)
- Are not a transfer student
- Please note: Requests to defer acceptance are not valid for the BSc in Nursing Program

For what reason can a student defer their acceptance?

Deferrals will be considered for the following conditions:

- International VISA/Study permit issues: Situations vary and circumstances must be disclosed below. If you have encountered a Visa/Study permit refusal, please enclose your refusal letter with this form
- Medical issue: A Medical note is required
- Gap year: The name of the organization/program must be presented on the form
- Other exceptional circumstance (this must be explained on the Request to Defer Form)



Things to be aware of:

- Students are sometimes ineligible for scholarships if they are not making a direct transition from high school to university
- Students are most uncomfortable with the prospect of being "a year behind" their peers
- The two most challenging times for gappers are:
 - June of their grade 12 year
 - September of their gap year.

Role of the Professional Advisor

What Can You Do To Support?

- Be informed of this pathway AND refer when you are not informed
- Provide guidance to determine if the gap year pathway is the right one
 - Look at what they want to get out of their post-secondary experience. Will that be possible?
- Provide sample activities they can engage in on their gap year
- Advise on the transition from gap year to post-secondary
- Inform them of the Gap Year Certification
- Be an accountability partner, check in on them.


